DESCRIPTION

Rapid-setting, rapid-hardening, highly flexible, water/frost-resistant cementitious tile grout with built-in Microban® antimicrobial protection for walls and floors.

Use for

- Grouting porcelain, glazed and fully vitrified, glass and ceramic mosaics, marble and natural stone in dry and wet interior and exterior environments, including swimming pools. Follow guidelines to BS Standards (minimum 2mm joints for walls and 3mm for floors, size can change depending on size of tile and environments), Contact BAL TECHNICAL ADVISORY AND SPECIFICATION SERVICE for more information.
- For Joint widths: 1mm to 30mm
- Recommended for power showers, wet rooms, heated floors and overlaid timber floors.

Restrictions: NOT suitable for

 Food preparation*/storage areas,* Spas,* Jacuzzis, *Chemical Plants, *Power Showers with body jets and areas requiring *waterproof grouting.

SURFACE PREPARATION General

Before grouting, ensure that:

- 1. Tile adhesive has fully set, as indicated on adhesive packaging or BAL TECHNICAL DATA SHEET.
- 2. Open joints are clear from excess adhesive, protected from contamination and are clean, dry and free from loose debris.
- The amount of clean cold water used with the cementbased grout is consistent from mix to mix when grouting larger areas.
- 4. Lighting conditions during the installation of tile fixing and grouting should not be 'Appreciably different' from the final (Permanent) lighting. Where possible, check the grout colour with the final lighting conditions.
- The colour consistency is checked when using the same grout applied between different tile types i.e. porous bodied or porous stone tiles vs. porcelain or denser stone.

IMPORTANT NOTE: Do NOT use in temperatures below 5°C or in damp conditions.

If grouting porous tiles in temperatures above 25°C, dampen joints with clean water prior to grouting.

If grouting externally, provide protection against inclement weather during grouting and for as long as possible afterwards. It is recommended that all external tiling applications include a DPM or a surface DPM can be applied prior to tiling.

If grouting shower installation, BAL MICROMAX3 ECO is water-resistant but NOT impervious to water and not a substitute for a waterproof tanking system.

Recommendations:

 Provide waterproof tanking protection for tiling background substrates, particularly plaster or plasterboard (e.g. by using BAL TANK-IT or BAL WATERPROOF 1C).

Ensure tiles are fixed with a solid bed with a water-resistant adhesive

(2) Tiles must be grouted using BAL ABSOLUTE GROUT for wave pools.

(3) In wet conditions waterproof background with BAL TANK-IT or BAL WATERPROOF 1C.

(4) Modify grout with BAL ADMIX GT1, Pre-diluted 1:2 with water by volume or BAL ALL-IN-ONE PLUS Prediluted 1:3 with water by volume.

(a) Do not use shower for at least 2 weeks after completion of grouting – BS 5385:Part 4
(b) Do not fill pool for at least 3 weeks after completion of grouting - BS 5385:Part 4

NOTE: When grouting soft glazed tiles or tiles with a metal decor or lustre, care should be taken to ensure they are not damaged/scratched. Porous stone should be presealed. If there is any doubt, a test area should first be grouted in an inconspicuous area.

MIXING

Use a BAL MIXING BUCKET or other suitable bucket.

1. Slowly add approximately 5 parts powder to 1 part clean cold water by weight. (see table) Never add more water than recommended as this may lead to colour inconsistencies in the finished grout.

2. Mix until lump-free mortar achieved.

3. Allow mixed grout to stand for 2-3 minutes before remixing for 30 seconds. No further water should be added after original mixing. Avoid entraining air by mixing at too high speed.

Product Size	Usage	Approx., clean cold water required per size
2.5kg	Wall and floor areas	0.512 litres
5kg	Wall and floor areas	1.025 litres
10kg	Wall and floor areas	2.050 litres

NOTE: If using electric drill mixer, blend at slow speed (i.e. under 300rpm). Ready for immediate use. Pot life at 20°C: approx. 30 minutes.

NOTE: Pot life/setting time will vary slightly with temperature: higher temperatures = shorter; lower temperature=longer. Do NOT add more water to mixed grout as this would reduce final strength.

APPLICATION

Grouting procedure

- Check potential staining risk: apply grout to a few tiles in a small trial area. If discolouration occurs or difficulties are encountered with cleaning off (surplus grout), apply BAL PROTECTIVE SEALER and repeat the trial.
- Work in small areas with a grout float or squeegee. Completely fill tile joint with mixed grout and compact well, removing excess grout from tile surface as work proceeds.
- Allow approx. 15minutes for the grout to dry (at 20°C) or when the surface of the grout joints is dry enough to be touched (NOT fully set/Cured).
- 4. Using a dampened sponge or sponge board, clean the surface diagonally to grout lines. Use as little water as possible to wash off the grout but rinse out sponge/sponge board frequently with clean water. NOTE: Do NOT allow water to enter un-grouted joints.
- 5. When the grout has set sufficiently within joints, polish the tile surface with dry clean cloth.
- 6. Clean any remaining light haze from the surface next day, using water and a white emulsifying pad and gripper.
- 7. Wait a minimum 3 hours before subjecting tiles to normal service conditions.

If completing a shower, do NOT use shower for at least 2 weeks.

CLEANING

Always use cleaning products suited to the tile type. For best long-term protection, regularly clean using a general alkaline cleaner such as BAL MICROSHIELD TILE CLEANER (with Microban[®] antimicrobial protection).
