Acrylic primer for walls and floors

DESCRIPTION

Rapid-drying, coloured, acrylic primer for tiling substrates. A modified acrylic polymer dispersion for preparing wall and floor backgrounds prior to fixing of ceramic, mosaics and natural stone tiles in dry or wet internal and external environments.

Use for

- Preparing background for receiving adhesives, levelling Compounds and for BAL WP1 waterproof coating.
- BAL PRIME APD isolates products containing calcium sulphate such as gypsum plaster and anhydrite screeds when using cement-based adhesives.
- Providing stability to friable surfaces and reducing the porosity of absorbent backgrounds/bases.
- Preventing the formation of air bubbles and prolonging the flow time with levelling compounds.

Restrictions: NOT suitable for

Metal, painted surfaces, existing non-porous surfaces (existing glazed or porcelain tiles), Epoxy coatings, some manufactured board systems (check with manufacturer first) and in total immersion areas (e.g. swimming pools)

PRODUCT INFORMATION

Composition: Modified acrylic polymer dispersion.

Colours: Green/blue. Pack sizes: 2.5 litre Key Features:

- Rapid drying primer.
- Primer is green to help ensure that a complete and even coating is obtained.
- Stabilises dusty tiling substrates.
- Reduces background porosity.
 Drying time: 15-30 mins. (at 20°C)

- (1) Tiles must be grouted using BAL ABSOLUTE GROUT.
- (2) Prime with neat BAL Prime APD (3) Prime with BAL PRIME APD diluted 1-part BAL PRIME APD to 1 parts clean cold water by volume (See coat requirements below)
- (4) In wet conditions check priming requirements with the primary waterproofing system used.
- (5) Prime with BAL PRIME APD, first coat with 1:1 with water, second coat undiluted 90° to the first.
- (6) Check suitability for the intended purpose with the manufacturer.
- (7) When used with BAL RAPID-MAT or tile backer board.
- (8) When used in conjunction with BAL RAPID-MAT/BAL FLEXBONE VAried.
- (9) Seal back face and edges with undiluted BAL BOND SBR.

Note:

(a) Do not use shower for at least 2 weeks after completion of grouting – BS 5385: Part 4

SURFACE PREPARATION

Priming

BAL PRIME APD can be used on the following areas as a primer before tiling:

Prime with 2 Undiluted coats (second coat applied at 90° to the first):

- Plaster walls (when using a BAL cementitious adhesive.
- Tongued and grooved floorboards (when using BAL SINGLE PART FASTFLEX or a BAL flexible cementitious adhesive with BAL RAPID-MAT).

Prime with 1 coat (Diluted 1:1 with Clean Cold water):

- Plaster walls (when using a BAL ready-mixed adhesive), only if dusty or porous.
- Cement screeds/concrete/brick/rendering

Prime with 2 coats first coat diluted 1:1 with clean water followed by a second coat undiluted (second coat applied at 90° to the first):

- Calcium sulphate screeds.
- Anhydrite screeds.

The following substrates may require priming on the face of the board. Check suitability and requirements with the manufacturer.

Prime with 1 coat

undiluted or diluted 1:1 with water by volume (refer to board manufacturer for guidance:

- BAL BOARD
- Lightweight tile backer boards
- Calcium silicate boards
- Fibre-reinforced cement sheets

For levelling or waterproofing, refer to the relevant BAL product data sheet for priming guidance.

MIXING

- 1. Shake container well before use.
- 2. Can be used undiluted/diluted 1:1 by volume of BAL PRIME APD and clean water and thoroughly mix.

APPLICATION/USAGE

Usage procedure

IMPORTANT NOTE: Do NOT use in temperatures below 5°C.

- 1. Ensure surfaces are free from dirt, grease and other loose materials. Brush down highly polished surfaces with a stiff bristle brush before priming.
- 2. Apply 1 2 coats of BAL PRIME APD using a clean brush from a container, diluted or undiluted as appropriate (See SURFACE PREPARATION above). Allow to dry between coats.

NOTE: If using on floor, do NOT allow to form puddles.

- 3. Ensure even coverage.
- 4. Allow to dry thoroughly for 15-30 minutes before applying adhesive.
- 5. Clean product from tools using clean water.
